**ORDER APPROVING RECEIVER'S DISCHARGE ACCOUNTING STATEMENT,
AUTHORIZING RESERVE FOR DISCHARGE EXPENSES, APPROVING FINAL
RETIREMENT PLAN DISTRIBUTION REPORT, DIRECTING FINAL DISCHARGE,
AND AUTHORIZING DESTRUCTION OF OBSOLETE RECORDS**

THIS MATTER came on upon the Florida Department of Financial Services', as Receiver of Nationwide Public Employees Trust ("NPET"), Motion for Order Approving Discharge Accounting Statement, Authorizing Reserve for Discharge Expenses, Approving Final Retirement Plan Distribution Report, Directing Final Discharge, and Authorizing Destruction of Obsolete Records. The Court having reviewed the pleadings of record and being otherwise fully informed:

It is therefore **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** as follows:


1. The Receiver's Discharge Accounting Statement is hereby approved and this Court adopts the Discharge Accounting Statement;
2. The Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to retain \$4,085.00 as a reserve for "wind up" expenses of the Receiver. Any remaining surplus funds shall be paid to the Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund;
3. The Receiver is hereby authorized and directed, after final discharge, to destroy any obsolete records in the Receiver's possession;

4. The Division of Rehabilitation and Liquidation is hereby authorized to remit to the Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund any assets which may be recovered following the discharge of this receivership if, in the Division's sole discretion, the value of the recovered assets does not justify the reopening of this receivership;

5. Assign all mortgages, notes, or other liens, on property located in Florida, in favor of NPET to the Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund;

6. The Receiver's and Trustee's administration of the NPET Retirement Plan and this receivership shall be deemed satisfied, approved, and confirmed in all respects, and the Receiver, its deputies and all other employees, including, but not limited to, the NPET Retirement Plan Trustee, shall be discharged without further order of this Court, from any and all duties, obligations and liabilities in the administration of the NPET Retirement Plan and this receivership at 12:01 a.m. on December 31, 2009.


