**ORDER APPROVING RECEIVER'S STATUS REPORT
AND PLAN OF REHABILITATION**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court on the *Receiver's Status Report and Motion for Approval of Rehabilitation Plan*, the Court having reviewed the pleadings of record, and otherwise being fully informed it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. The *Receiver's Status Report and Motion for Approval of Rehabilitation Plan* (hereinafter "Motion") is hereby GRANTED.

2. All outstanding Cumberland bonds are hereby cancelled effective sixty (60) days from the date of this Order.

3. A claim filing deadline is hereby established for the Cumberland receivership. The claim filing deadline shall be one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of this Order. All claims are to be submitted to the Receiver on or before the claim filing deadline. In the event that a claim is submitted after the claim filing deadline, it shall be denied unless otherwise ordered by this Court.

4) The Receiver is authorized to issue Notice to claimants including, but not limited to, publication as set forth in the *Receiver's Status Report and Motion for Approval of Rehabilitation Plan*.

5) Any offers of settlement not accepted and finalized (including execution of any and all necessary settlement documents) by the date of this Order are hereby withdrawn.

6) The review of claims and objection process set forth in the *Receiver's Status Report and Motion for Approval of Rehabilitation Plan* is hereby APPROVED.

7) The collateral release process set forth in the *Receiver's Status Report and Motion for Approval of Rehabilitation Plan* is hereby APPROVED. The Receiver is further authorized to file a limited Abandoned Property Report, if necessary.

8) The Receiver is authorized and directed to continue ongoing operational activities in the receivership as it deems necessary and appropriate.

9) The Receiver is authorized and directed to continue asset recovery efforts in the receivership as it deems necessary and appropriate.

10) The authority granted to the Receiver under Chapter 631, Florida Statutes, and the Consent Order previously entered by this Court on February 26, 2004 is still in effect.

11) The automatic stay provisions set forth in Section 631.041, Florida Statutes, and the Consent Order are still in effect.




