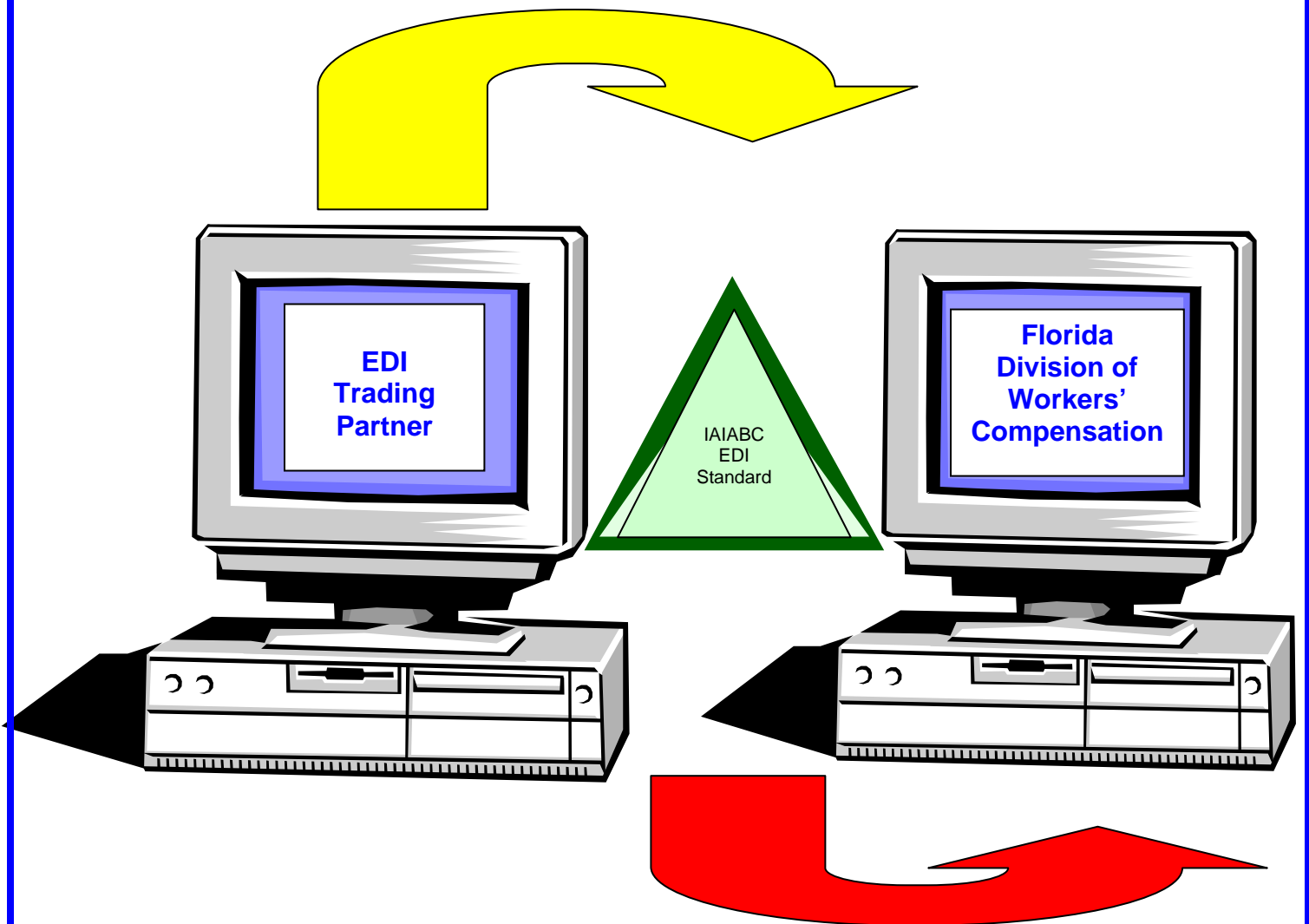

# Florida Claims EDI R3 Implementation Manual (September 2006)

## INTRODUCTION

The Florida Division of Worker's Compensation Claims EDI R3 Implementation Manual (Sept. 2006) documents the filing requirements for the timely and accurate submission of Electronic First Reports of Injury or Illness, Electronic Notices of Denial, Electronic Claim Cost Reports, Electronic Notices of Action or Change, including Change in Claims Administration, and Electronic Suspensions and Reinstatements of Indemnity Benefits. Various Excel tables and worksheets contained in the manual provide detailed data element requirements for data elements designated as mandatory, mandatory/conditional, if applicable, etc., and the conditions under which mandatory/conditional data elements will be required to be reported; also, the timeframes for reporting required Claims EDI Filings which correspond to filing requirements set out in Rule Chapter 69L-56, F.A.C.; and finally, processing edits that will be applied to each data element and which will determine the acceptance of a record or the generation of an error that will result in either rejection of the filing or further inquiry by the Division regarding a "non-fatal" error identified on reconciliation reports.

This manual should be utilized in conjunction with the IAIABC EDI Implementation Guide for Claims, Release 3, June 1, 2006 Edition, and Supplement. The FL Claims EDI R3 Event Table is designed to convey under what circumstances FL Claims “events” are required to be reported to the Division of Workers’ Compensation.

The FL Claims EDI R3 Element Requirement Table provides FL's data element requirements for each First Report Of Injury (FROI) or Subsequent Report Of Injury (SROI) Maintenance Type Code (MTC).

## FL Claims EDI R3 Edit Matrix

The FL Claims EDI R3 Edit Matrix conveys to the sender the edits Florida will apply to each data element and the edits that will be applied based on population of the data element in the transaction. Editing results determine the outcome for processing the data and communicates the results that will be returned in the Acknowledgment Record for each specific transaction.

The FL Claims EDI R3 Edit Matrix consists of 5 components:

1. ***DN-Error Message worksheet*** which contains FL's "standard" editing for R3 data elements.
2. ***Value Table worksheet*** which contains FL's acceptable code values
3. ***Match Data Table*** which explains what data elements FL will use to determine if the report will create a new claim or will find an existing claim or transaction in FL's database.
4. ***Sequencing worksheet*** which illustrates FL's required sequencing of transactions to identify what transaction(s) must have preceded the current transaction being reported.
5. ***Duplicate Processing worksheet*** which contains FL's edits and restrictions to determine if a transaction is a "duplicate" of the current transaction being reported.
6. ***Population Restrictions worksheet*** which contains FL's edits and restrictions applied to each data element(s).
7. ***FL Min\_Max (Proprietary) worksheet*** which contains FL's minimum and maximum parameter amount edits for certain fields in the transaction.
8. ***FL Calculations (Proprietary) worksheet*** which contains FL's edits for calculating the expected gross weekly amount for each Benefit Type to validate the accuracy of the Benefit Type Amount Paid.
