IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

A) The Receiver is authorized and directed to notify claimants of the Receiver's recommendations by U.S Mail to claimant's last known address;

B) The Receiver's Global Claims Report is approved unless an objection is filed in writing on the date specified by the Receiver in the Notice of Determination. The date will be no less than thirty days from the date of this Order. Objections shall be filed with the Clerk of this Court, Leon County Courthouse, 301 S. Monroe Street, Tallahassee, FL 32301, and a copy shall be furnished to the receiver at Post Office Box 110, Tallahassee, Florida 32302-0110;


C) Objections shall clearly state the name and identification number of the person filing the objection;

D) Objections shall clearly state the factual and legal reasons supporting the objection and claim;

E) All objections shall be set for hearing at a later date and objectors notified;

F) A copy of this Order shall be mailed to each claimant and shall constitute notice of the filing of the Receiver's First Interim Claims Report and Recommendation on Claims.
