SUMMARY

Purpose

Pursuant to Section 29.0084(4)(a), Florida Statutes, the Department of Financial Services will review county expenditure reports for determining if counties have maintained their annual court-related expenditures based on what was reported the prior year. This review and analysis, as required by law, compares court-related expenditures from Fiscal Year 2009-2010 (FY 09-10) to Fiscal Year 2010-2011 (FY 10-11). The expenditures analyzed include: Facility Lease/Rent, Maintenance, Utilities, Security, Communications Systems and Services, Existing Radio Systems, Existing Multi-Agency Criminal Justice Information Systems and selected Local Requirement Programs.

Analysis

Expenditure data recorded in the Statement of County Funded Court-Related Functions Report was submitted by all 67 counties for FY 09-10 and FY 10-11. Counties shall maintain, but are not required to increase, their expenditures from FY 2009-2010 to FY 2010-2011. For FY 09-10 and FY 10-11, the counties reported expenditure totals of \$638,327,675.41 and \$646,631,388.00 respectively.
