SUBJECT: STATEWIDE EXPENDITURE OBJECT CODE LIST

The Department of Financial Services (DFS) has updated the Statewide Expenditure Object Code (SWOC) List to include the following improvements:

1. Added new column “Add Date to SWOC List.” – This column informs agencies when the expenditure object code was originally added to the SWOC List and the corresponding Agency Addressed Memorandum.
2. Added new column “Date of Last Information Update (1099 Reportable, W9 Required, Prompt Payment, Definition, etc.)” – This column informs agencies when the last update occurred regarding a particular expenditure object code and the corresponding Agency Addressed Memorandum.
3. The definition, long title, or short title has been updated for the following:
