D) Objections shall clearly state the factual and legal reasons supporting the objection and claim. Further, any person filing an objection shall submit documentation to support their claim;


E) The Court will not consider any information or documentation submitted after the objection is filed;

F) All objections shall be set for hearing at a later date and objectors notified;

G) The Receiver's procedure for addressing late filed objections is approved.

H) A copy of this Order shall be mailed to each claimant and shall constitute notice of the filing of the Receiver's First Interim Claims Report and Recommendation on Claims.
