## **Portal Instructions:**

- 1. Use the link below to access the State Fire Marshal website.
- 2. From the SFM site, select "Access The Public Portal"
- 3. On the Bureau of Fire Prevention site, under "Boiler Safety Section", find and click on Search for Boilers.
- 4. On the "**Search for Boilers**" page, enter the <u>numerical numbers of the address ONLY</u> (less is best on this search engine screen this numerical address is where the boilers are located)
- 5. In the "County" drop down box, select the county where the boilers are located.
- 6. Be sure to leave all other fields blank.
- 7. Click "**Search**" in the top right-hand corner.
- 8. Click the **blue file number** to find more information about that jurisdiction number only.

## **On-Line Payment Portal Instruction:**

If you would like to make an online payment and have a user account –

- 1. On the left-hand side on the Bureau of Fire Prevention Online Portal, select "Pay an Invoice"
- 2. Use your account information to log in and process the payment

If you would like to make an online payment and do not have a user account -

- 1. On the left-hand side of the Bureau of Fire Prevention Online Portal, select "Pay an Invoice"
- 2. In the header, use the "click here to register link" to create a user account.
- 3. On the Registration page, in the "Registration Type" drop-down box, \*VERY IMPORTANT\* select "Boiler Contact"
- 4. Complete the required fields and a username
