FIRESAFETY INSPECTOR II CERTIFICATION - REQUIREMENTS

To be certified as a Firesafety Inspector II, an individual must be certified as a Firesafety Inspector I in the State of Florida and must successfully complete 135 hours of certification training for Firesafety Inspector II or have received equivalent training in another state.

Documentation of training is to be submitted with the required Application for Firesafety Inspector II Certification (DFS-K4-1446), and Fire Inspector II Task Book (DFS-K4-2204) along with all other supporting documents.

Three 45-hour courses are required for certification. The courses are offered at the Florida State Fire College, Community and Junior Colleges throughout the state, and some of the Certified Training Centers.

2. BFST/ATPC/FFP 2541 PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEMS II
3. BFST/ATPC/FFP 2770 ETHICAL AND LEGAL ISSUES IN THE FIRE SERVICE

Task Book

The Inspector II Task Book provides the applicant an opportunity to demonstrate key job performance requirements while working in their respective organization. This task book is an evaluative tool designed to document that a candidate has demonstrated certain requisite skills required to meet a specific NFPA 1031 job performance requirement. Selected skill objectives in the task book are a supplement to the student learning outcomes and objectives met by successfully completing the Inspector II program curriculum. The applicant is responsible for the maintenance, completion, and submission of this document, including obtaining the required signatures.
