Policing your credit report on a regular basis will allow you to quickly identify and report financial fraud.

- Check your credit report regularly.
- Place a fraud alert on your credit report to direct lenders to verify.
- Some victims of identity theft may not become aware of the problem until their credit ratings have been seriously damaged.
- Review your credit information regularly for signs of unauthorized accounts or other suspicious activity.
- You are entitled to a free copy of your credit report every 12 months, from each of the three major credit bureaus by visiting www.AnnualCreditReport.com.
