#### JOB SUMMARY

Professional firefighting duties of varied nature under the direction of a superior officer.

#### ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Responds to fire alarms with a fire company and performs firefighting duties as assigned.
- Operates varied pieces of fire apparatus and equipment to extinguish fires.
- Ventilates burning buildings to eject smoke and gases.
- Performs salvage and cleanup operations at fire scenes.
- Rescues and removes persons from danger.
- Makes periodic inspections of buildings to locate fire hazards.
- Attends training sessions in such subjects such as firefighting and inspection methods, equipment operation and emergency medical treatment.
- Performs cleaning and maintenance tasks on department buildings and equipment.
- Performs hydrant maintenance.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
