Firefighter/EMT

FIREFIGHTER/EMT: salary is \$35,635.85 annually, which includes F.L.S.A. Typically shift work: 24 hours on/48 hours off. Performs experienced protective service work controlling, extinguishing, and preventing fires and performing Basic Life Support at emergency scenes. ***All applicants must not have been users of tobacco products for at least one (1) year immediately preceding their application for employment as a firefighter with Brevard County Fire Rescue, and shall be required, as an absolute condition of continued employment, to refrain from smoking cigarettes, cigars, pipes, or use of any type of tobacco products of any kind (including smoking cessation products), at all times, whether on or off duty.*** In the event of a hurricane, major storm, natural or man-made disaster that may threaten the area, the employee will be required to perform emergency duties as directed.

REQUIREMENTS: Must possess **on the date of written testing**, a valid CPR card from an approved provider PLUS a valid State of Florida EMT Certification and both must be maintained during the term of employment. Applicants must possess **on the date of written testing** a Florida State Fire Fighter Certificate of Compliance or Letter of Completion from the State of Florida Bureau of Fire Standards and Training PLUS a current and valid CPAT card from a recognized and licensed IAFF CPAT Training Center. Must possess a valid Florida Driver's license and maintain said license during the term of employment. *** **Copies of all required certifications and licenses must be presented at the time of written test administration.** *** Applicants will be required to take and pass both a written fire skills and a practical medical skills test. Veterans of the United States Armed Forces, with an honorable discharge, entitled to Veteran's Preference under Florida Statute, Chapter 295, must submit their applicable DD-214, valid military certification, and/ or military discharge papers to Human Resources **by date of written testing**. Veteran's Preference points will be added to a passing written test score. Applicants must be able to successfully complete a criminal, driver's license, and personal background investigation conducted by Brevard County or another agency. Applicants must be able to successfully complete a physical examination, in accordance with the most current NFPA 1582 guidelines and be found Fit for Duty under those guidelines. *****Information regarding the written test date, time, and location will be emailed to qualified applicants two (2) weeks prior to the testing date.*****
