SOUTH WALTON FIRE DISTRICT SEEKING FIRE INSPECTOR

Agency: The South Walton Fire District (SWFD) is a professional fire/rescue agency located in Walton County Florida. SWFD maintains 5 fire stations, a communications center and provides beach safety services for the South Walton Beaches. SWFD is responsible for Fire Protection, Emergency Medical Services Transport, Lifeguards, Hazard Mitigation, Public Fire/Life Safety Education and Prevention as well as 911 Communication Services for an area of 84 square miles. South Walton is an area that runs from the Okaloosa/Walton County line on the west, to the Walton/Bay County line on the east and from Choctawhatchee Bay (Intracoastal Waterway) north, to the Gulf of Mexico on the south. Included in this area are 26 miles of beaches and 26 miles of inland waterways. The population of South Walton ranges from 20,000 to over 100,000 during the tourist season.

Job Description: The South Walton Fire District is currently seeking applicants for the position of Fire/Life Safety Inspector. Duties will include the ability to plan, organize, coordinate and administer all activities related to fire inspection activities. The individual must be able to: respond to general correspondence, telephone inquiries and requests to inspect; maintain prescribed records and other materials pertinent to inspections; complete duties and assignments in a timely manner; maintain liaison with key personnel who are involved with fire protection activities; study and research publications to ascertain the latest concerns, techniques and developments in the fire protection industry; and participate in all aspects of fire prevention/life safety to include public education. This position reports directly to the SWFD Fire Marshal.

Requirements and Qualifications: SWFD is looking for a self-motivated individual that requires limited supervision and can interpret and apply fire codes as they pertain to the fire inspection. Qualified candidates must possess the following:

- Minimum 18 years of age
- High School graduate or equivalent diploma required
- Valid Florida driver's license and acceptable driving record
- Florida State Fire Safety Inspector I certification
- Skill in reading building plans and specifications
- Ability to climb stairs, ladders and work outdoors in all types of weather
- A combination of education and experience may be considered.
