NOTICE TO AGENTS OF SUSPENSION OF AGIC, INC.

Your agency has been identified as having written personal auto insurance policies issued by AGIC, Inc. This is to inform you that AGIC, Inc. was suspended from the writing of *new* insurance policies as of May 24, 2013. As of the date of this Notice, AGIC can write renewal business, but cannot write any *new* business. This restriction is contained in Florida Statutes:

624.420 Order, notice of suspension or revocation of certificate of authority; effect; publication.—

(1) Suspension or revocation of an insurer's certificate of authority shall be by the order of the office. The office shall promptly also give notice of such suspension or revocation to the insurer's agents in this state of record. **The insurer shall not solicit or write any new coverages in this state during the period of any such suspension** and may renew coverages only upon a finding by the office that the insurer is capable of servicing the renewal coverage. The insurer shall not solicit or write any new or renewal coverages after any such revocation. (Emphasis added)

Therefore, no later than receipt of this Notice, you and your agency should cease and desist from writing any new coverages through AGIC.
