Title: Florida Hazardous Material Technician Certificate

Date: October 19, 2016

This certification is voluntary. To receive the Florida Hazardous Material Technician Certificate, a candidate must successfully complete the 160 hours modified IAFF Technician Program, meet the performance competencies of the **SERC Training Guidelines**, complete the **SERC Haz-Mat Technician Task Book**, and pass the state written examination (100-question multiple-choice) with a minimum score of 70%.

To be eligible to apply for the State Examination, the candidate must:

- complete the required **Hazardous Material Technician Certification Application**
- pay a processing fee, and
- submit the completed Haz-Mat Task Book signed by Fire Chief for Hazardous Materials Technician Certification.

Pre-requisites for this certification are Florida Firefighter I or II certification and Hazmat Operations.
