<u>Presentation Update</u> – All agencies have successfully logged into Florida PALM. There have been over 600 unique users logging in (98% of original planned users). As of Thursday, July 29, over \$3.6 billion in deposits have been processed. Nearly 32,000 journal entries have been posted and over 300,000 warrants have been issued.

- <u>Combined Implementation</u> Now called the 'Financials Wave'; Central, Departmental, and Phase 2 functionality is set to go live in July 2024. The Master Readiness Workplan (MRW) has been updated with tasks throughout September 2021. The Project Team is currently receiving agency and Executive Steering Committee (ESC) considerations and feedback for the Financials Wave implementation.

• Florida PALM Operational Processes – Florida PALM is not only live and launched, but is also partially operational. Accounting and Auditing has used each day since the Cash Management System (CMS) Wave Go-Live to learn the new system. The new processes have brought forth conversations with agencies to describe how the new system is intended to work and how we all can adapt. Moving forward, with this new operational piece of Florida PALM, patience will be needed as we all learn together.

- GASB 84/97 and GASB 90 Implementation The CAFR Team has submitted information to all agencies related to GASB 84/97 and GASB 90. Please note that GASB 84 does not add and/or take anything away from financial statements, but instead identifies and reclassifies fiduciary funds within financial statements. Moving forward, Agency Funds will now be called Custodial Funds. GASB has come up with criteria to determine what will be considered a Custodial Fund. Beginning with GASB 74, the CAFR Team is asking that you apply the tools to help identify funds. Next, analyze your Governmental Funds to determine if there is any fiduciary activity.
