- 2. Keep an eye on children while cooking, as the stove will be hot. Kids should stay at least three feet away from appliances, hot food and liquids.
- 3. If you fry a turkey, do it away from the home and make sure the bird is completely thawed before cooking.
- 4. Don't overfill the fryer.
