ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on to be heard on the Ancillary Receiver's Motion For Authority To Reimburse the Insurance Commissioner's Regulatory Trust Fund; To Transfer Funds to the Ancillary Receiver; For Approval of Final Accounting and Final Discharge, and the Court being fully advised in the premises, it is

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that:

1. The Ancillary Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to reimburse the Insurance Commissioner's Regulatory Trust Fund \$23,199.24 for receivership costs and expenses paid to June 30, 1989.
2. The Ancillary Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to transfer all remaining funds in this receivership, a total of \$103,943.11 plus any accrued interest, to the Domiciliary Receiver.
3. The Ancillary Receiver's Final Accounting is hereby approved and when the Ancillary Receiver has complied with numbered paragraphs one and two of this order, the Ancillary Receiver's administration of this receivership shall be satisfied, approved, and confirmed in all respects; and the Ancillary Receiver, its deputies and all other employees shall be discharged, without any further order of this Court, from any and all duties, obligations and liabilities in the administration of this receivership at 12:01 am on the 12th day of September, 1989.
