You are receiving this communication as a former policyholder, claimant or agent of Northern Capital Insurance Company ("Northern Capital"). On April 12, 2010, the Florida Department of Financial Services was appointed by the Second Judicial Circuit Court of Leon County, Florida as the Receiver for Northern Capital. Early on the morning of May 14, 2010 a break-in occurred at the office building where Northern Capital is located. During the break-in a number of items were stolen, including a total of nine (9) computers. It is not known what data, if any, existed on those computers' hard drives.

At this time, the Receiver is unaware of any policyholders, claimants or agents that have been affected by the theft of these computers and any data that may have been stored on those computers; however, in an abundance of caution, the Receiver is placing you on notice of this potential threat pursuant to Section 817.5681, Florida Statutes.

Please take steps with your financial institutions, credit card issuers and other similar entities to advise them of this potential concern and verify that your account information, status, and transactions are correct. It is recommended that you immediately obtain a current copy of your credit report and examine it for suspicious activity.

Please note that the Receiver does not disseminate your personal information except to the appropriate entities, such as the Florida Insurance Guaranty Association, that require certain information to ensure the service of pending claims, or pursuant to Court authorization. If you have been or are subsequently approached based on your status as a former Northern Capital policyholder or claimant by an individual or entity other than the Receiver or American Integrity Insurance Company of Florida (an authorized third party company offering replacement coverage to certain Northern Capital policyholders), please immediately contact the Receiver using the contact information found at the end of this notice.

This matter was referred to the appropriate law enforcement agencies for investigation. <u>In the event</u> that you discover any suspicious activity concerning the unauthorized use or dissemination of your personal information, please contact your local law enforcement agency.
