wind up expenses of the Department.

10. The Department is authorized, after final discharge, to destroy any obsolete records

in the Department's possession.

The Department is authorized to remit to the appropriate guaranty associations any 11.

assets which may be recovered following the discharge of this receivership if, in the Department's

sole discretion, the value of the recovered assets does not justify the re-opening of this receivership

estate, including any judgments or amounts recovered from judgments.

12. Without further order of this Court, the final discharge of the Department of its

responsibilities in this receivership estate shall be as of 11:59 P.M. on January 18, 2019.
