ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY STAY PROHIBITING THE COMMENCEMENT OR CONTINUATION OF THIRD-PARTY INSURANCE LITIGATION AGAINST WINDHAVEN'S POLICYHOLDERS

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the Department's Motion for Order Granting a

Temporary Stay Prohibiting the Commencement or Continuation of Third-Party Insurance Litigation

Against Windhaven's Policyholders. The Court, having reviewed the Motion, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises,

it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

- A. The Department's Motion is hereby Granted in all respects.
- B. All parties to actions, lawsuits, or other proceedings for which Windhaven Insurance Company is obligated to defend any party pursuant to an insurance policy are enjoined and restrained from commencing, continuing, or otherwise taking action regarding such litigation for a period of 60 days from the date of entry of this Order or until such date that this Court issues an order appointing the Department as Receiver of Windhaven for purposes of liquidation, whichever date comes first.
- C. With respect to any third-party action brought against a Windhaven policyholder, no statute of limitations shall run from December 9, 2019, through and until the date of the expiration of the temporary stay ordered herein.
