Florida PALM is coming!

Florida PALM will launch in July 2021 for cash management functionality. Are you ready? Here's what you can expect when logging on.

To log on to Florida PALM, you'll select our agency and enter your network credentials (same credentials as your computer log on). Our agency's security, which is called Identity Provider, will authenticate your log on and connect you to Florida PALM.

If you encounter a logon error, you should contact our agency's <u>Security Access Manager</u> (also known as our SAM). They will help you with Florida PALM access, much like a FLAIR Access Custodian does today.

CMS Wave Launch

The Florida PALM website has a <u>count-down to launch clock!</u> Check out how many days we have until July 6, 2021!

Florida PALM can be viewed in several different <u>web browsers</u>. You'll also be able to access Florida PALM from any device with internet connection. Now that's modern!

Our agency will work through a detailed checklist before implementation that will help with final preparations before our transition. In the meantime, here are a few things our workforce can begin asking:

- Do our end users know Florida PALM web-based training is available in the People First LMS?
- Have we shared updated process and procedures that reflect the CMS Wave changes?
- Do our end users know our Tier 0 support team and Security Access Managers?
- What is our plan during the time when the Cash Management System (current CMS) is turned off and Florida PALM is turning on? What processes need to be

- accounted for during this time?
- Is there anything the Project Team should know that may affect our transition?

As a reminder, the <u>CMS Wave Summary</u> provides a list of changes that will be in effect in Florida PALM.
