In preparation for the Financials Wave, begin analyzing your agency's business systems to determine if they need to connect (interface) with Florida PALM. It is important to understand Florida PALM functionality in order to analyze which business systems need to be retained and interfaced with Florida PALM, and which do not. MRW task FUNC41 supports your analysis of your agency business systems. Note, that data you receive today may be different or no longer needed due to a process change at the Financials Wave therefore these tasks are crucial to your operations.

We are sharing initial interface and conversion layouts for the Financials Wave. Interface layouts will continue to be published on a rolling basis through September 2021. All conversion layouts have been published. All layouts are draft and will updated through agency feedback. Collaborate with your business and technical teams to plan for your required interfaces and data that needs to be converted from an agency business system for the Financials wave launch (July 2024).
