#### **USER ACCEPTANCE TESTING**



Just announced: Pre-UAT activities will be hosted starting October with Advisory Council member agencies!

Although UAT Online has experienced some delays, agencies should continue to prepare by monitoring the progress of prerequisite training and refining UAT materials. This refinement should include confirming the data being collected, updating business processes, creating operational training materials, and enhancing end user understanding of future processes.

#### **Prerequisite Training Materials**



UAT Prerequisite Training Materials were made available at the beginning of July in the **People First Learning Management System** 

(<u>LMS</u>). You can find details regarding these materials in the Knowledge Center's <u>UAT Prerequisites</u> article, which includes a downloadable <u>'How To' graphic</u> to help agencies locate the prerequisite materials. It is recommended end users view these materials before attempting to navigate the UAT environment.

Training Liaisons should monitor their agency's training progress and update the **Prerequisite Tracking worksheet** in the agency's Smartsheet workbook.

To help monitor this progress, a report is available to Agency People First Learning Management System (LMS) Administrators showing end user progress. In the Knowledge Center's <u>UAT Prerequisites</u> article, under the <u>Training</u> <u>Liaison Role in Completion of UAT Prerequisites</u> section, click the arrow next to the *LMS - Program Status Report* (CSV) headline for instructions to access this report.

Additional materials will continue to be released on a rolling basis as part of the UAT training resources.



#### **ADDITIONAL RESOURCES**



#### INTERFACE TESTING






#### KNOW YOUR CHANGE IMPACT
