Operational Readiness Testing Why am I here today?

To familiarize Operational Readiness Testing (ORT) Participants with testing activities and expectations.





Operational Readiness TestingWhat is ORT?

- ORT validates agency processes and operations that are used to support the Florida PALM system function are ready for production use.
- ORT will closely mimic the experience of working with Florida PALM after CMS Wave launch and will be executed by people who will perform the processes in production.
- ORT participants include interfacing agencies, DFS Divisions of A&A and Treasury, Solution Center, and Production Support.



Operational Readiness TestingWhat ORT is not?

▶ ORT is **not**:

- Online application testing
- Regression testing of system functionality
- End user training
- Validation of full business readiness

Operational Readiness TestingWhat is involved?

ORT scenarios:

- are high-level descriptions of functionality or processes to be validated.
- are opportunities to validate operations support processes and tools are functioning as expected.
- are used to assess the process knowledge of the resources who will be performing the operations tasks and functions.
- can be executed by performing a role play or execute a step-by-step instructions from job aids or training materials.



Operational Readiness Testing

Operational Readiness Testing What are expectations of my agency?

- Review the batch schedule and identify which interfaces your agency should transmit and retrieve/process.
- Connect to your designated Managed File Transfer (MFT) folders on Florida PALM production environment.
- Provide files for your inbound (to Florida PALM) interfaces according to the batch schedule.
- Process files for your outbound (from Florida PALM) interfaces according to the batch schedule.



Operational Readiness Testing What are expectations of my agency?

- Complete the execution of applicable ORT scenarios and send a confirmation email to the RC confirming the completion of ORT.
- Work closely and collaboratively with the RC to provide timely inputs and feedback so that the schedule for ORT is met.





Operational Readiness Testing How will we manage and resolve issues?

- Work with appropriate agency support team as first line of support, for questions and issues that may arise during ORT.
- Florida PALM will track and manage system defects found during ORT. Readiness Coordinators (RCs) will do the following:
 - act as liaisons for any system defects that require input or resolution from agencies.
 - establish meetings and working sessions with agencies to review, investigate, and resolve system defects, if needed.
