Mr. Steven Fielder called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. with a roll call of the Executive Steering Committee (ESC) members. Sixteen of the 17 members were present.

Mr. Jimmy Cox gave an update on the Advisory Council April meeting topics and the themes identified for further discussions. Mr. Cox shared production support updates, including CMS remediation progress by the Project, new end user support tools, and upcoming Round Table opportunities. Mr. Fielder led a discussion on the Settlement Agreement between the State and Accenture through the end of the current fiscal year.
