The Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C53 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:

- 200.0160 Provide ability to notify a collection recipient or garnishment vendor of deduction adjustments based upon CCPA limitations (e.g., prorated deductions, dropped deductions).
- 2) Request to add new Payroll Accounting Department Budget Table Entry Changes (C103) customization. This customization allows for the simplification of online entry into the Department Budget pages used for setting up accounting distributions at the position and department level. In addition, the customization allows the user to designate a primary funding source. (Cost \$64,054)

The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C103 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:

- 200.1102 (New) Provide ability for updates made to Position Funding earnings to automatically be applied to Position Funding Deductions and Taxes.
- 200.1103 (New) Provide ability to designate a primary funding source within position funding setup.
- 3) Request to add new Updates to Payroll Accounting Position Allocation Process (C110) customization. This customization will allow for the required State of Florida updates to the delivered actuals distribution process in payroll accounting, including running during pre-confirm calculations. As delivered, actuals distribution can only be run after payroll is confirmed. The payroll costs that will be distributed to the accounting setup cannot be determined until actuals distribution is run. This customization includes allowing actuals to be run for off-cycle payrolls. The customization provides agencies the ability to have a "point in time report" to anticipate cash or budget negatives. (Cost \$134,002)

The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C110 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:

- 200.1112 (New) Provide the ability for agencies to review and adjust payroll cost distributions prior to payroll being confirmed.
- 4) Request to add new Payroll Accounting Entries (C116) customization. The customization will create a custom configuration mapping table that will provide the information related to the additional liability and cash accounting lines including Enterprise Fund, Business Unit and other ChartFields that will need to be created by the custom Commitment Accounting Actuals (PAYGL02) process. The customization includes a custom Commitment Accounting Actuals process that will record the liability and cash accounting lines for the Enterprise's Fund, Business Unit and other ChartFields in the HR Accounting Line table within HCM Payroll. The Accounts Payable (AP) liability entries that need to be sent to AP will be populated based on the custom configuration and custom Commitment Accounting Actuals process. This customization will allow the Budget Date on the HR Accounting line to be populated in HCM based on the defined FCO Resource Category and Subcategory budget period value. (Cost \$153,596)

The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C116 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:

- 200.1117 (New) Provide the ability to generate payroll accounting liability and cash lines that can be recorded to the Enterprise Business Unit / Fund.
- 5) Request to add the new Suppress Supplier Registration User Profile (C121) customization. This customization prevents a supplier user profile from being established when a supplier is created via the Supplier Registration Form.

In Florida PALM, agencies/enterprise users will request the creation of a new/updated supplier record via the online Supplier Registration Form. As delivered, the Supplier Registration Form is typically used by external entities (i.e., suppliers) to request the establishment of a supplier record to receive payment for goods and services provided. A feature of the Supplier Registration Form includes requiring the requestor to define a User ID and password that the system uses to create a

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user profile to allow a requestor to log into the system with basic security roles to perform actions that are transactional/informational in nature. Florida PALM will not be implementing the capability to allow suppliers to log into the system, hence, the Supplier Registration Form will only be used by agencies to request a supplier record be created/updated. As a result, the functionality is requested to be modified to prevent requiring an agency to define a unique User ID and password each time they request a supplier record be created, which is systematically established as a user profile. (Cost \$26,038)

The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C121 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:

 30.1026 (New) – Provide ability to prevent the systematic generation of a supplier user profile when creating a new supplier via the Supplier Registration Form.

Business Benefit/ Justification

(Provide the tangible/intangible value(s) that support the Project's goals) The respective changes to the requirements and customizations enable Florida PALM to design the appropriate solution for the Financials and Payroll Waves.

Implications of Not Making the Change

(If we do nothing, what is our "Impact Prediction" to the project in terms of risk or issue) The desired solution design and business requirements would not be met by delivered Florida PALM functionality. Failure to implement or update the requested customizations would result in the following implications:

Garnishment Change Notifications (C53):

This is a request to cancel the garnishment change notifications customization based on the
design decision that notifications will not be sent when there are deduction adjustments to
involuntary deductions. Without this change a customization would be built that would have
limited use.

Payroll Accounting Department Budget Table Entry Changes (C103):

 Without this customization, a primary funding source may not always be able to be determined, impacting information that gets sent to external HRIS systems (e.g., People First) and LAS/PBS budget related processes. In addition, agencies would be required to enter repetitive information on multiple pages of the application impacting the efficiency of information being entered into Florida PALM.

Updates to Payroll Accounting Position Allocation Process (C110):

Without this customization, the position allocation process would not be able to run for off-cycle
payroll and would result in a delay of the payroll accounting information being sent to Financials
until an on-cycle payroll is processed. This would impact Supplier Payments related to payroll
and information within General Ledger.

Payroll Accounting Entries (C116):

Without this customization, the liability and cash related payroll accounting entries that are
generated in FLAIR today would not be able to be generated and the enterprise non-operating
budget would not be consumed. This customization also creates the accounting entries that are
needed to reserve cash and move monies from agency funds to the applicable enterprise fund.
As delivered, the payroll accounting entries are recorded against the agency Business Unit and
Fund and the state currently has payroll accounting entries that are recorded against the
Enterprise Business Unit and Fund.

Suppress Supplier Registration User Profile (C121):

Without this customization, the system would require agencies requesting a new supplier record
to define a User ID and password for every request, which the system would subsequently
establish a user profile that would not be utilized. A unique User ID and password would have to
be created for each new supplier record added (not system user).
