PCR Need Description <i>(Include description of change, why it is needed, how it was discovered)</i>	<p>After execution of Amendment 8 and as a result of payroll solution design conversations, the Department of Financial Services (DFS) has requested the following changes to Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements and Attachment 5.2 – Customizations.</p> <p><u>Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Request to add the following requirement to support the addition of the Pre-Tax Benefit Assessment (C124) customization requested in the Attachment 5.2 – Customizations section below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 200.1118 (New) – Provide the ability to calculate employer FICA (Social Security and Medicare) contributions saved as a result of the pretax benefit programs. Request to add the following requirement to support the addition of the Interest Calculation on Writ of Garnishment (C125) customization requested in the Attachment 5.2 – Customizations section below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 200.1119 (New) – Provide the ability to calculate the amount of interest due on a writ of garnishment based on the interest rate established by the CFO. Request to add the following requirement to support the addition of the Paycheck Record Table (C126) customization requested in the Attachment 5.2 – Customizations section below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 200.1120 (New) – Provide the ability to track payroll related processing status that will enable rerunning of payroll related interfaces and provide paycheck related status information. Request to add the following requirement to support the addition of the Agency Adjustment of Payroll Earnings (C127) customization requested in the Attachment 5.2 – Customizations section below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 200.1121 (New) – Provide the ability for agencies to initiate a reduction in earnings or request stop of a payment that requires approval based on HRIS data that has been loaded for payroll processing. <p><u>Attachment 5.2 – Customizations:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Request to add new Pre-Tax Benefit Assessment (C124) customization. This customization will calculate the employer FICA contributions (Social Security and Medicare) saved as a result of the pretax benefit programs for salaried employees, in accordance with s. 110.161(7), Florida Statutes. The savings that are calculated as employer payroll costs are used for the administration of the pretax benefits program. (Cost \$43,501) <p>As delivered, benefit and general deductions are not able to calculate deduction amounts based on tax rates with limits. A custom solution is needed since the Pre-Tax Benefit Assessment is calculated based on specific benefit deduction codes multiplied by the combined percentage of Social Security and Medicare. The calculation will take into account if the employee has reached the maximum for Social Security and use only the Medicare percentage if the limit has been reached.</p> <p>The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C124 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 200.1118 (New) – Provide the ability to calculate employer FICA (Social Security and Medicare) contributions saved as a result of the pretax benefit programs. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Request to add new Interest Calculation on Writ of Garnishment (C125) customization to comply with s. 77.081, Florida Statutes. This customization will calculate the amount of interest that is due on a 		

	<p>writ of garnishment based on the remaining garnishment balance after each payroll completes. (Cost \$45,354)</p> <p>As delivered, garnishment related interest functionality is not calculated within PeopleSoft HCM. A custom solution is needed to calculate the interest related to a writ of garnishment based on the remaining balance once the payroll has completed.</p> <p>The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C125 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 200.1119 (New) – Provide the ability to calculate the amount of interest due on a writ of garnishment based on the interest rate established by the CFO. <p>3) Request to add new Paycheck Record Table (C126) customization. This customization will create a custom table to store information that is needed to track daily sending of payroll information to external systems and additional statuses related to the payroll payment that would be available for viewing by agencies and BOSP. (Cost \$41,519)</p> <p>As delivered, post confirm processes are run at the completion of the on-cycle payroll including off-cycle related payments. Florida PALM plans to run post confirm processes after the completion of each day there are payroll payments. The information is needed by external systems and for payroll accounting related information on a more timely basis than just sending after on-cycle payroll runs. This customization will create a page that allows the tracking of processes and payment related information that can be viewed by agencies and BOSP.</p> <p>The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C126 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 200.1120 (New) – Provide the ability to track payroll related processing status that will enable rerunning of payroll related interfaces and provide paycheck related status information. <p>4) Request to add new Agency Adjustment of Payroll Earnings (C127) customization. This customization will allow agencies to adjust payroll earnings, via a custom page, that have been loaded via HRIS systems. Agencies will be able to reduce earnings amounts/hours or to stop a payroll payment during the processing window but prior to payroll confirm once the transaction has been approved. (Cost \$90,207)</p> <p>As delivered, earnings adjustments made directly on the paysheet are typically completed by a central organization and thus do not require approval. However, the decentralized process by agencies to update certain payroll information directly requires a custom solution that will allow agencies to be able to reduce earnings on a customized page that will update the delivered paysheet once the transaction has been approved.</p> <p>The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C127 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 200.1121 (New) – Provide the ability for agencies to initiate a reduction in earnings or request stop of a payment that requires approval based on HRIS data that has been loaded for payroll processing.
<p>Business Benefit/Justification <i>(Provide the tangible/intangible value(s) that support the Project's goals)</i></p>	<p>The requested requirements and customizations enable Florida PALM to design the appropriate solution meeting requirements for the Payroll Wave.</p>

<p>Implications of Not Making the Change <i>(If we do nothing, what is our "Impact Prediction" to the project in terms of risk or issue)</i></p>	<p>The desired solution design and business requirements would not be met by delivered Florida PALM functionality. Failure to implement or update the requested customizations would result in the following implications:</p> <p>Pre-Tax Benefit Assessment (C124):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Without this customization, the Pre-Tax Benefit Assessment would not be able to be calculated and included in the employer related charges associated with payroll. The calculation would need to be done outside of payroll which would require manual processing steps by agencies, Division of State Group Insurance and BOSP. This could lead to the need for additional staff to handle the manual processing steps. <p>Interest Calculation on Writ of Garnishment (C125):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Without this customization, interest for writ of garnishments would have to be calculated outside (manually) of Florida PALM and garnishment balances would need to be updated manually by BOSP. This could lead to the need for additional staff to handle the manual processing steps. <p>Paycheck Record Table (C126):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Without this customization, the daily post confirmation processes that send information to external systems would not be able to be reprocessed and there would not be a way to have agencies or BOSP view the additional information related to the payroll payment. Off-Cycle payments, as delivered, are attached to the next available on-cycle payroll and the off-cycle payments are included in downstream processing once the on-cycle payroll is confirmed. Based on the volume of off-cycle supplemental payroll payments that would be processed, this could lead to a delay in payroll payment information being received by external systems impacting accuracy and timeliness of payroll information. The additional fields that need to be tracked to indicate that off-cycle payment information has been processed by Florida PALM interfaces would not be viewable by agencies or BOSP, except by developing additional queries/reports. Based on the number of interfaces that are being designed within Florida PALM for payroll, if the status of payment information cannot be tracked accurately information could be incorrectly sent or excluded. <p>Agency Adjustment of Payroll Earnings (C127)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Without this customization, agency adjustments of payroll earnings would need to be made by BOSP within the paysheet as updates made directly to the payline do not require approval. Without this customization, if agencies were provided access to the paysheet they would have the ability to add, modify, and delete any earnings related to the paycheck being processed without approvals being required, which could impact the accuracy and correctness of employees pay.
