IV&V Update

Project Management

- The IV&V Team is tracking the delayed tasks in the Florida PALM Project Schedule
- As of the end of October, the Project Schedule reports 180 late tasks, and of those, 172 are related to D640 – Development of the Master Data Configuration Workbooks
- The Schedule Performance Indicator continues along a positive trend and is currently reporting at 0.93. Both the decrease in number of delinquent tasks and continued improvement of the SPI demonstrates a decreasing risk rating to the overall project schedule.



IV&V Update Stage Gate 1

- The IV&V Team reviewed the Stage Gate 1: Ready to Build Criteria and delivered a Stage Gate 1 Assessment Report on November 1, 2023
- The IV&V Team performed reviews of Functional Design Documents for quality and completeness and determined that the quality of the Segment I and Segment II Functional Designs is sufficient
- The IV&V Team found that the Florida PALM Project Team not only met but is ahead of schedule for the defined Stage Gate 1 Criteria
- As a result, the IV&V Team recommended that the Florida PALM Project was ready to proceed with the Stage Gate 1: Ready to Build



IV&V Update Open Findings

- Finding 12 Inconsistency in Requirements Traceability
 - Opened Issue in the IV&V September Monthly Report
 - All identified inconsistencies were corrected prior to acceptance of D636 –
 Completion of Solution Design (Requirements) Segment I
 - Additional cross checks in place to mitigate future inconsistencies
 - Florida PALM IV&V Team to review traceability as part of D637 Completion of Solution Design (Requirements) Segment II to verify cross checks were effective



IV&V Update Functional Design

- The IV&V Team attended
 - Segment I Design Workshops
 - All sessions were well attended by agencies, provided key information, generated questions, and provided clarification on Florida PALM functionality
- All Segment II Functional Designs have been approved
 - Ready to Start Build Stage Gate Approved
 - Florida PALM IV&V Team provide Stage Gate Assessment Report that recommended moving forward with the Stage Gate



IV&V Update Functional Design

- Segment III and IV are much larger than Segment II
 - 73 functional designs for Segment II, 116 for Segment III, and 120 for Segment IV
 - Much of the Payroll functionality is part of Segment III and this functionality is very complex
 - Onsite meetings with People First to discuss interface files (10/25 10/27)
 - Action Items and Decisions were recorded in RAID log for follow-up and finalization of the interface files



IV&V Update Readiness Tasks and Agency Engagement


Readiness and Implementation Forums

- Held on October 26
- Project Manager Liaison Forum
 - 39 attendees, representing 25 agencies
 - Topics: Stakeholder identification and collaboration
- Change Management Liaisons and Training Liaisons Forum
 - 54 attendees, representing 26 agencies
 - Topics: Organizational Change Management strategies throughout the project lifecycle
- Next forums anticipated for early next year



Readiness and Implementation



- ▶ RW Task 326: Released March 13; Due October 27 (7-month duration)
- ▶ In September, additional columns added:
 - System Readiness Activity
 - Readiness Level of Effort
 - Planned Integration
 - Business Functions Supported
 - Business Purpose
- ▶ 29 agencies reported "complete", 6 reported work is still "in progress"
- ▶ 906 agency business systems logged → 356 (39%) marked as high criticality (must be operational at go-live)



- Project team review criteria
 - Each ABS or interface has complete information all cells are complete
 - Each ABS that will require remediation has complete documentation of the current state
- Initial Project team review findings

Agency Business Systems:

- 4 agencies appear to be complete
- 29 agencies have incomplete Current State Documentation
- 17 agencies have incomplete
 ABS information

Interfaces:

- 7 agencies appear to be complete
- 15 agencies with no information
- 13 agencies with incomplete information (e.g., filenames, data validation)




Agency Planned Integration with Florida PALM

- RCs are following up and reviewing submissions with agencies
- Some agency lack of clarity as to what "documentation complete" means for this point in the readiness lifecycle

- Implications of not completing all elements of the task are:
 - Potential delay in completion of future tasks that rely on information about "current state"
 - Missing or incomplete future tasks that require agencies to submit documentation
 - Compressed timeline or extra workload catching up with while juggling new tasks
 - Inaccurate or incomplete information for agency and Project team use for planning (e.g., testing)





- Project Takeaways:
 - Provide clearer instructions (e.g., What does "done" mean? or What are task minimums?)
 - Create planned midpoint task checks to review progress
 - Use monthly touchpoints to
 - Review progress and discuss agency understanding
 - Request to see progress if completing tasks outside of Smartsheet
 - Possible change to RW Task Tracker and reporting metrics



Readiness and Implementation Bimonthly Agency Readiness Status Reports

- Sponsor Confirmation Timeliness: 30 on time, 1 late, 4 still unconfirmed
- Risks:
 - Open Risks increased by 60%
 - Risks with Rating of 6 or higher increased by 32%
- Issues:
 - Open Issues increase by 48%
 - Issues deemed High or Critical increased by 79%
- Assumptions logged increased by 29%
- Agency Activities reported increased by 52%




Readiness and Implementation Bimonthly Agency Readiness Status Reports

 - Competing priorities and projects logged as risks

- A full assessment of the Project's review will be provided in the December ESC meeting





















Segment II Functional Design


- Segment III functional designs have been identified; DED is pending review and approval

Configuration Workbooks


- 314 configurations across 12 workbooks (align to 12 modules)

- 13 agency configurations across 6 workbook templates
 - The Agency Configuration Workbook activity establishes templates to obtain agency specific values to support transaction processing and controls.
