PCR Need Description (Include description of change, why it is needed, how it was discovered)		<ul> <li>Amendment 12, Attachment 1 – Statement of Work (SOW) specifies the number of reports, interfaces, connections, forms, workflows, and WorkCenters that are included in Accenture's scope. Contractor maintains a tracker to manage the consumption of reports, interfaces, connections, forms, workflows, and WorkCenters throughout the Project lifecycle. Separately, Contractor is responsible for providing Project Team Training and maintains a tracker of the remaining Project Team Training budget.</li> <li>The purpose of this PCR is to exchange unconsumed reports, interfaces, and Project Team Training for additional connections. The SOW includes 600 connections, 88 were consumed for CMS functionality, and 512 are available for the remainder of the Contract Term. Using agency submitted data from RW tasks 557 - Confirm Interface Inventory for Cycle 2 Interface Testing, the Department identified the need for additional connections (as of May 9, 2025, the Project identified 523 total connections) and the Parties have agreed to the following exchange to add 104 connections with corresponding subtractions from reports, interfaces, and Project Team Training:</li> </ul>

		Connections will be consumed after the following activities are complete: 1) connection request is sent from Department to Accenture, 2) Accenture configures the connection in MFT (if needed) and the PeopleSoft custom configuration, and 3) Accenture provides evidence to the Department that the connection is configured. Connections removed by the Department prior to completion of these activities will not consume from the available connections budget. Deliverables D663 Completion of Interface Testing Segment I and D671 Completion of Interface Testing Segment II will include up to the number of connections from the original SOW. Once the connections are defined for the Deliverables, any connection removal from the Deliverables will reduce the number of connections tied to these Deliverables. A new Work Product will be created for the work associated with connections not included in the Deliverables for those connections that are known at the time the Work Product is defined. Connections identified after the Work Product commences will be worked outside the Work Product as individual efforts. Once connections are defined for the Work Product, any connection removal from the Work Product will reduce the number of connections tied to the Work Product. This PCR does not alter the obligation for Contractor to provide a refund to the Department for the cumulative amount of fees related to unconsumed reports, interfaces, and connections.
