General Observations

Submission:

- 4 agencies submitted after the due date (+2 from last bimonthly)
- Sign off for 7 agencies was by other than Sponsor (+1 from last bimonthly)
- One Agency Sponsor role remains vacant

Completed or Open Items:

- New columns added showing Project Impact and completion verification
- Many agencies are not updating and providing % complete throughout the task timeline –
 Use this as a way to track and report status
- Some agencies are taking advantage of the status comment field
- 32 outstanding / late tasks across 15 agencies, concentrated around Current State and Project Management Tasks (due December 2023)

- Observations:
 - Some are not reviewing issues regularly – Planned or Actual Resolution Dates have passed
 - Lack of technical documentation limits ability to remediate
 - Issues closing due to:
 - COA listing provided
 - More information about Florida PALM functionality has been provided

Readiness Activities

- ▶ 23 agencies reported 500+ activities since the last reporting period
- Observations:
 - Marked increase since last bimonthly
 - Still seeing some agencies only reporting RW Tasks and Project-led activities
 - More and more diverse meetings to support RW task completion
 - Separate meetings with large system / agency stakeholders

- Collaboration with other agencies
- More data analysis / clean up
- Business Process Mapping training
- Post workshop debriefs
- Creating messaging for future end users (surveys, email distribution, handouts / flyers)

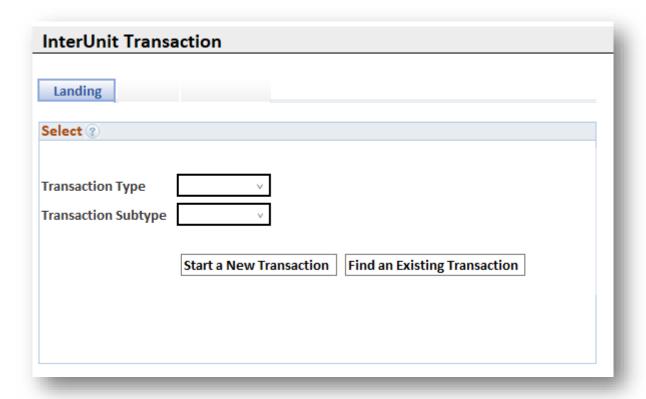


Inter/IntraUnit Module

- Custom module that supports the transactions between agencies (InterUnit) and within agency funds (IntraUnit)
- Sending and receiving is one transaction
- Link and control subsequent moves from the original transaction
- Inter/IntraUnit module supports:
 - Encumbrances
 - Accruals (e.g., Due To/From, payables/receivables)
 - Payments for goods and services
 - Transfer of funds
 - General Revenue Service Charge payment
 - Trust Fund Loans (issuance and repayment)
 - Reclassifications
 - Advances
 - DFS IU transactions on behalf of other agencies
 - Carry forward processes

Key Functionality

- Sending and receiving sides must balance
- Offsetting lines are defaulted
- Sending and receiving processors can communicate
- Controls are established by transaction type
- Controls are established for the sending/receiving to support financial reporting
- Transaction not posted until both sending and receiving agency sides of the transaction are approved, and successfully pass edit and budget/cash check

IU Encumbrance

Key Functionality

- •Records to KK Encumbrance Detail Ledger and consumes budget
- Update (increase/decrease), Close, and Cancel
- •IU transactions can pay against the Encumbrance and the balance will get relieved
- •Can view IU transactions paid against the IU encumbrance
- •Can view the remaining encumbrance balance
- •Encumbrance can be used for the Carry Forward Process

- •Can only use expenditure account values
- •Can only create an encumbrance for open budget periods
- Sending Approval Workflow



Payable/Receivable

Key Functionality

- Establishes an accounts payable for the sending agency and an accounts receivable for the receiving agency
- Can reference IU Encumbrance which will relieve the encumbrance
- Can close the Payable/Receivable which will record reversing accounting entries for the remaining balance.
- IU Payables can be used for the carry forward process

- •Sending agency can use payable and expense account values
- •Receiving agency can use receivables and revenue account values
- Sending and Receiving Approval Workflow
- DFS Audit Workflow



Due To/Due From

Key Functionality

- Establishes the Due To for the sending agency and the Due From for the receiving agency
- Referencing IU Encumbrance relieves the encumbrance
- Can close the Due To/Due From accrual which will record reversing accounting entries for the remaining balance.
- Due To/Due From accrual can be used for the Carry Forward Process

- •Requires use of Due To/Due From Account values
- Sending agency can only use Due To account values
- •Receiving agency can only use Due From account values
- •Receiving must use the matching Due From Account value associated with the Due To Account value
- Sending and Receiving Approval Workflow
- •DFS Audit Workflow



Trust Fund Loan Issuance

Key Functionality

- Records transfer of fund cash
- Records the accounts payable accrual for the sending agency and an accounts receivable accrual for DFS

- •Only DFS can establish the issuance of the loan
- Does not allow receiving agency to change the Fund
- •Receiving Approval Workflow



Trust Fund Loan Repayment

Key Functionality

- Repayment transactions are linked to the Trust Fund Loan Issuance transaction
- Drops in the accounting lines from the issuing transaction
- Relieves Trust Fund Loan balance
- DFS receiving distributions lines are systematically populated and approved

- •Requires receiving agency to select the IU Trust Fund Loan Issuance accrual transaction
- Sending approval workflow



Advance Issuance

Key Functionality

- Records transfer of fund cash
- Records the accounts payable for the sending agency and an accounts receivable for the receiving agency
- Can reference IU Encumbrance which will drop in the accounting lines and relieve the balance
- Can reference IU accrual which will drop in the accounting lines and relieve the balance

- Does not allow receiving agency to change the Fund
- May only use Advance Account values
- Sending and receiving approval workflow
- DFS Audit approval workflow



Advance Repayment

Key Functionality

- Repayment transactions are linked to the issuance transaction
- Drops in the accounting lines from the issuing transaction
- Can reference IU Encumbrance which will drop in the accounting lines and relieve the balance
- Can reference IU accrual which will drop in the accounting lines and relieve the balance

- •Requires receiving agency to select the IU issuance accrual transaction
- May only use Advance ChartFields
- Sending and receiving approval workflow
- DFS Audit approval workflow



Expenditure/Revenue

Key Functionality

- Records the payment and receipt of funds between agencies
- Creates the accounting lines without issuing a warrant
- Can relieve IU Encumbrance
- Can relieve IU Accrual balance

- •Sending agency can only use expenditure account values
- •Receiving agency can only use revenue account values
- Sending and receiving approval workflow
- DFS Audit approval workflow



Transfers

Transfers between Funds, either between agencies or within an agency. Includes Transfer, Federal Funds Transfer, and Residual Equity Transfer

Key Functionality

- Can relieve IU Encumbrance
- Can relieve IU Accrual balance
- Sending agency can designate a "Receiving Fund." This requires the receiving agency to receive the transfer within that fund however receiving agency can add accounting lines to redistribute those funds

- Prohibits use of GR Fund
- Sending and receiving approval workflow
- •DFS Audit approval workflow



General Revenue Transfer

Key Functionality

- Records the transfer in or out of General Revenue Fund
- Can relieve IU Encumbrance
- Can relieve IU Accrual balance
- Sending agency can designate a "Receiving Fund." This requires the receiving agency to receive the transfer within that fund however receiving agency can add accounting lines to redistribute those funds

- Requires use of GR Fund
- Sending and receiving approval workflow
- DFS Audit approval workflow



GR Service Charge Payment Transfer

Key Functionality

- •Records the payment to GR for the GR Service Charge
- Can relieve IU Encumbrance
- Can relieve IU Accrual balance
- Can attach supporting documentation
- •DFS distributions lines are systematically populated and approved

Revenue to Revenue

Key Functionality

• Record revenue transfer within or across agencies

- •Must use revenue Category and Account values
- Sending and receiving agency approval workflow
- •DFS Audit approval workflow



IU Transaction Reclassifications

Key Functionality

- Records a reclassification of existing IU transaction
- Links to original IU transaction and will drop in the accounting lines to reclassify
- Can redistribute to lower-level agency ChartFields (e.g., grant, OA1)
- Can perform partial or whole reclassification

- Must select posted IU transaction
- •Cannot reclassify more than the original amount
- Sending and receiving approval workflow
- DFS Audit approval workflow



Payroll Reclassifications

Key Functionality

- Records reclassification of Payroll expenditure
- Can reference the HCM Payroll transaction(s) to link
- Can redistribute to lower-level agency ChartFields (e.g., grant, OA1)
- Can perform partial and whole reclassification

- •Will require payroll COA values
- Sending and receiving approval workflow
- •DFS Audit Workflow



Expenditure Reclassifications

Key Functionality

- Records the reclassification of expenditure
- Can perform summary level reclassification
- Can redistribute to lower level agency ChartFields (e.g., grant, OA1)

- Can only use expense Account values
- •Cannot restore more budget than was originally expended (checks appropriations)
- Prohibits use of Payroll ChartFields
- Sending and receiving approval Workflow
- •DFS Audit Workflow



Revenue Reclassifications

Key Functionality

- Records the reclassification of revenues
- Can perform summary level reclassification
- Can redistribute to lower-level agency ChartFields (e.g., grant, OA1)

- •Can only use revenue Account values
- Sending and receiving approval workflow
- DFS Audit workflow



Reverse IU Transaction

Key Functionality

- Creates a new transaction to reverse the existing IU transaction
- Links to original IU transaction

- Must select existing posted IU transaction
- •Cannot add additional lines or change COA values
- Sending and receiving approval workflow
- DFS Audit approval workflow



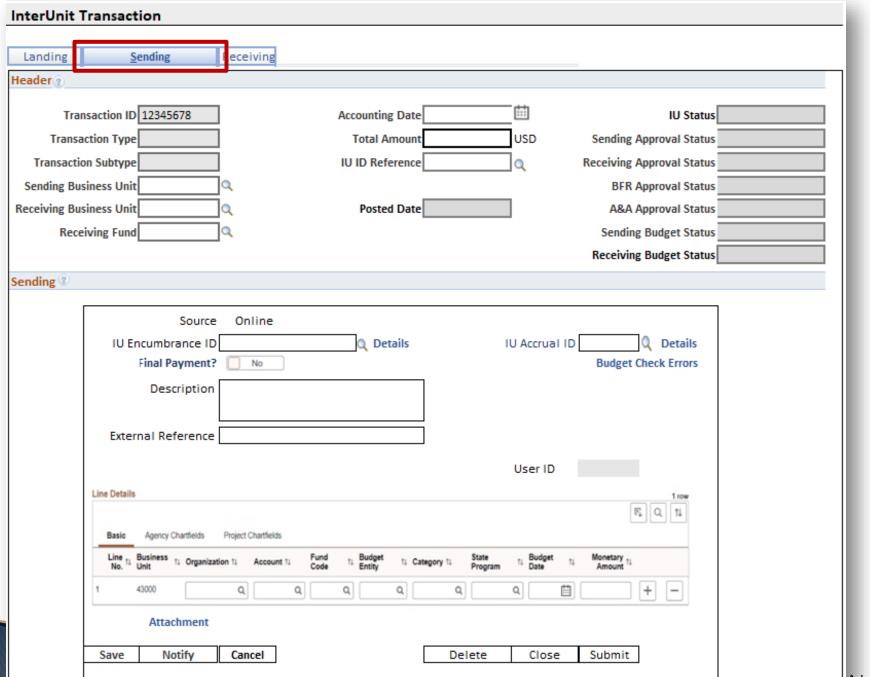
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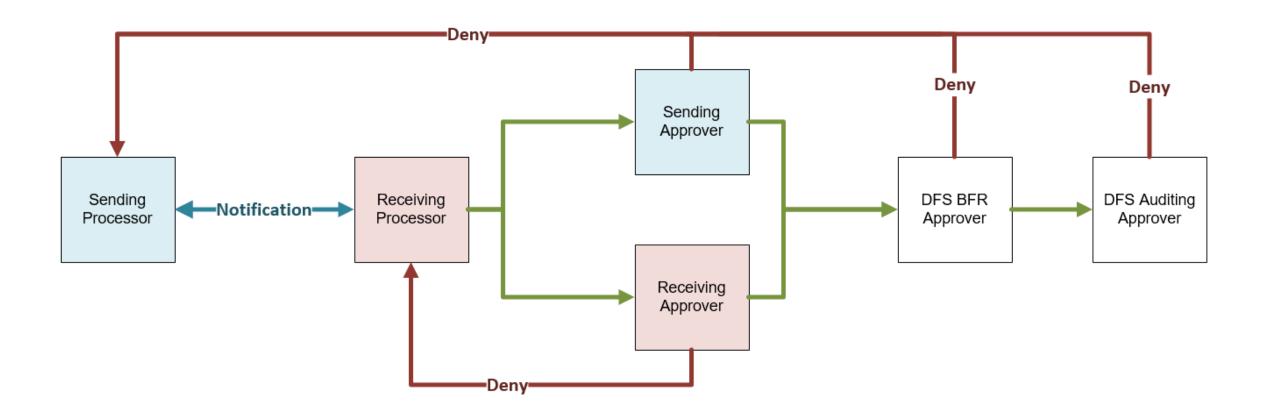




APPROVAL WORKFLOW

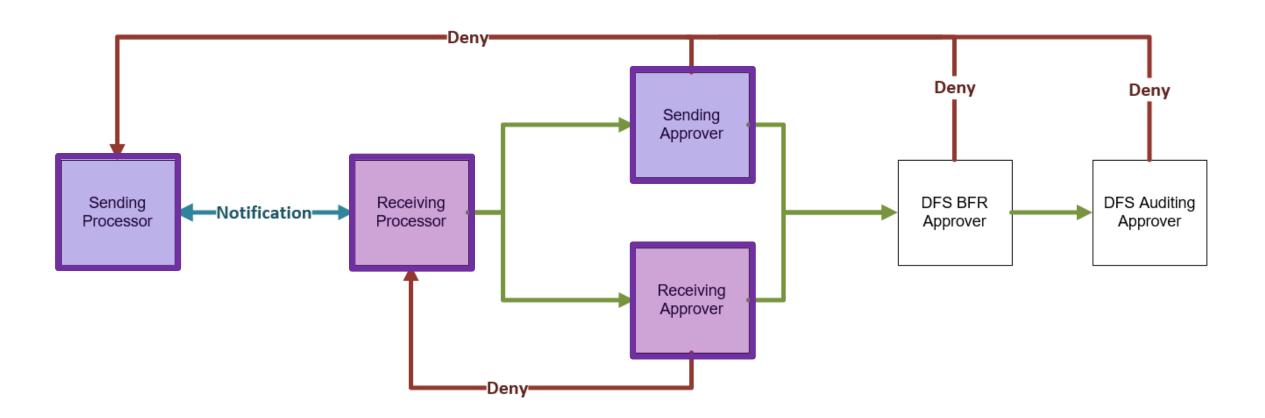


InterUnit Workflow

Reports

▶ Inter-IntraUnit Transaction Detail Report (IUR005)

 A query report that lists transaction details for Inter/IntraUnit module transactions including Inter/IntraUnit expenditures, revenues, transfers, advances, reclassifications, encumbrances, and accruals.

Inter-IntraUnit Transaction Reconciliation Report (IUR003)

 A report by transaction Inter/IntraUnit ID that reflects the sending information and the receiving information. The report will show data for any subsequent Inter/IntraUnit transactions occurred.



Reports (Continued)

GR Service Chart Report (IUR002)

 A custom report that lists service charges by ChartField combination for each Agency.

Inter-IntraUnit Accrual Report (IUR004)

 A custom report detailing Inter-IntraUnit accrual activity including issuance, payments, and balances.

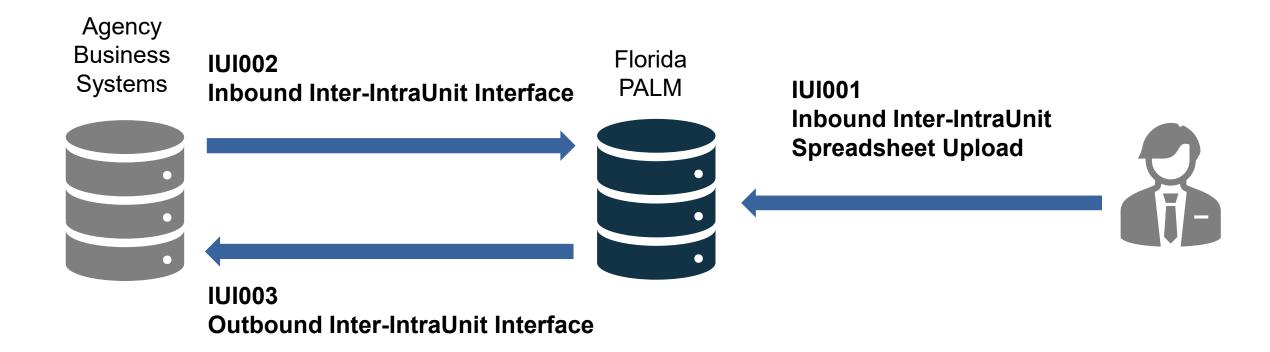

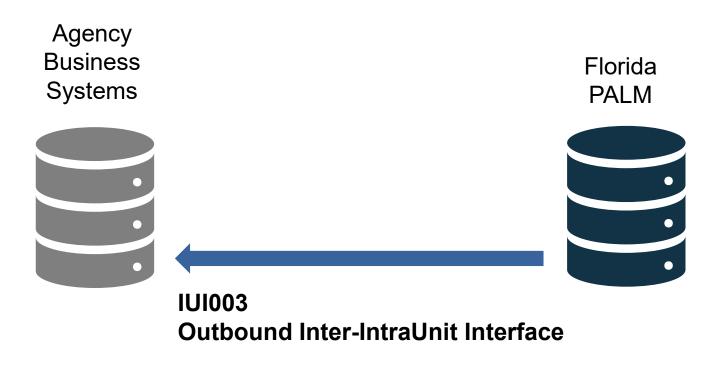

- Posted IU transactions are sent to both the sending and receiving agency
- Received IU transactions are sent to the receiving agency



SECURITY AND END USER ROLES



Security

IU end user roles can view transactional data for both sides of the transaction if their agency is associated with the transaction

Change Impacts

- MFMP IU Encumbrances and payments must be entered in Florida PALM IU Module via online entry or Spreadsheet Upload
- Sending and receiving is one transaction and therefore must balance
- Streamlines Form 3 process
- Allows receiving agency to input their accounting lines instead of using default values
