1	I thought the SpeedType wasn't saved in the database?	It is not saved. It's only the key to populate the ChartField value(s). It is not a value that needs to remain with the journal.
2	Does the speedkey have to be 10 CHAR or can it be less than 10?	It can be less than 10, but not more than 10.
3	Does the system periodically save your data, or do you have to do it manually?	Every change made in the system should be saved at that time by the end user.
4	To be clear – we will need 4 SpeedTypes for disinvestments (one for each line we would manually enter)?	Yes, one for the disinvestment line and one for offset cash line. Treasury SpeedTypes for corresponding treasury lines have already been created for agency use.
5	Can you disable the UserID field, if it is not supposed to be completed?	That field cannot be greyed out/disabled.
6	For SpeedType UserID, can you add multiple users, or is it either only one person or universal?	It is either one person or universal. It is recommended to leave that value blank so that agency end users have access to all SpeedTypes created.
7	Can the SpeedChart values be uploaded or do they need to be created manually?	SpeedCharts will be implemented during Financials Wave. We will share once we have more information on SpeedCharts.
8	The SpeedTypes are established. When the funds are depleted from a fund, then the administrator can change the fund the money comes from. Do you recommend this practice?	It is up to the agency to determine if you want to use a SpeedType or type over the fund value. It is up to the agency how to work forward when values need to be updated.
9	Do you recommend that agencies create standardized naming conventions?	Yes. A standard naming convention is recommended. It will help users know which SpeedType to use on a particular journal (line).
10	Is there a limit on how many ChartField values can be added to a SpeedType? We would like to include SPC code, OCA etc.	There is not a limit. You may add some agency unique values if desired.
11	When we search for SpeedType can we use a wildcard. For example, 7601%	The SetID field requires all 5 values to be input to represent the business unit. The use of a wildcard in SpeedTypes search serves no purpose.

12	The SpeedType value used is not saved in transaction history, did you say it disappears after processing the transaction?	Yes. It's only the key to populate the value. It is not a value that needs to remain with the journal.
13	Do you have to setup an offset when creating a SpeedType or will Florida PALM create the offset entry when you process your transaction?	When a line is added, a second line is automatically added, and all values copied. You will have to update the account to represent the offset cash. You will have to establish the offset line to match the disinvestment line, the system will not do it for you.

15	Is the error report demonstrated just for SpeedTypes? Can you run the error report immediately after input to check for errors?	The referenced error sheet was a result of the spreadsheet journal upload. It is a part of the edit checking processing. In Florida PALM the journal verification edit check will reveal any errors.
16	Can the SpeedType be mass created by uploading an Excel file? Mass SpeedType upload?	This is not an option for CMS Wave. SpeedTypes are established one by one for now. They are manually entered in a spreadsheet and uploaded.
17	Is there currently any guidance on "standard naming conventions" for SpeedTypes? If so, where?	No, SpeedType naming convention is up to the agency.
18	The SetID is set to equal so it must be the whole value. Can the SetID operator be changed?	The 5-digit value is required even if the option is changed to "=" or "in".
19	With the spreadsheet/template can you set up a rule to have a character limit in the cell or will that mess up the upload process in the system?	The template cannot be changed. It is configured to bring in values and figures input. Changes to that template will fail upload.
20	For the Treasury portion of the two SpeedTypes, the speed key for treasury is located to be chosen secondary for the first line. Will Florida PALM flip flop those so the treasury pool can be chosen first for the first line?	It is up to the end user to determine which order lines are created on the disinvestment journal.
21	If a SpeedType is created with the FUND blank, and the user enters the FUND manually on the journal; and then the user goes back and enters the SpeedType with the blank FUND, will the SpeedType	Yes, it will override with whatever values populate from the SpeedType.

	overwrite the manually entered FUND with the blank from the SpeedType.?
