DEFAULT FINAL JUDGMENT

This matter came before the Court on Plaintiff's Motion for Entry of a Default Final Judgment against Defendants, Heritage Cremation Provider, L.L.C., Legacy Funeral Services L.L.C., Anthony Joseph Damiano, and Joseph Damiano. After due notice to all parties, and the Court having considered the court file, pleading, and affidavits, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, states as follows:

1. A Default was entered by the Clerk of this Court against Defendants Heritage Cremation Provider L.L.C., Legacy Funeral Services L.L.C., Anthony Joseph Damiano, and Joseph Damiano on December 18, 2018.
2. Defendants are not minors, nor incompetent persons, nor are they members of the military services of the United States.

3. Defendants did not file any responsive pleading, appear, or otherwise defend in this action.

THEREFORE, IT IS ADJUDGED AND ORDERED that:

4. The Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter hereof and of the parties herein.

5. The Court incorporates by reference the well-pleaded facts alleged in the Petition to Enforce Agency Final Order, which facts Defendants have never contested by answer or other responsive pleading. These facts are taken as true.

6. Plaintiff's Motion for Default Final Judgment is granted.


7. Defendants are permanently restrained and enjoined from any further violations of chapter 497, Florida Statutes, including any and all unlicensed funeral services activities or direct disposition activities.

Heritage + Legacy

8. Pursuant to section 497.158(1), Florida Statutes, Defendants/collectively and severally, shall pay a total of \$10,000.00 to the Department of Financial Services. The payment shall be in the form of a cashier's check or money order payable to the Department of Financial Services, Revenue Processing Section, P.O. Box 6100, Tallahassee, Florida 32314-6100, and to be paid within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Order.

9. This Court shall maintain jurisdiction over this matter to enforce this Order, and to award such other equitable and further relief the Court deems just and proper.
