Disaster Home Repair Grants

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) recently announced the availability of grants to repair homes damaged in 2022 in a **Presidentially Declared Disaster Area**. Through the Single Family Housing Rural Disaster Home Repair Grants program, eligible very-low and low-income homeowners, as determined by the USDA, can receive grants up to \$40,675. Properties must be located in an **eligible rural area**.

Funds can be used on disaster related home repair expenses, including costs incurred prior to applying; site preparation; and the cost to transfer a manufactured home.

Applications are accepted year-round until funding is no longer available.

To get started, contact a USDA home **loan specialist in your area**.
