- Flying objects such as chairs, grills, umbrellas, etc. can cause severe injuries or damage during a storm. Tie down/ anchor objects as soon as you become aware of a storm.



- Both large and small trees can cause serious injury and damage especially as a result of high storm winds. Trim trees and branches around your home. Encourage and coordinate with your neighbors to do the same.



- Keep gutters clear of debris to direct water away from your home & reduce the possibility of flooding or water intrusion.
