



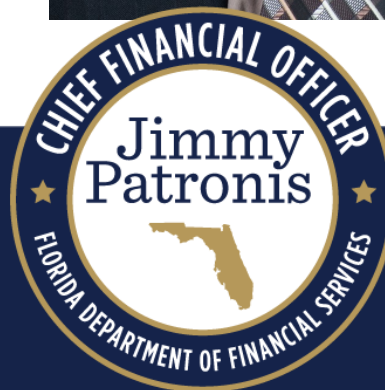

Eddie began his law enforcement career in 1982 as a Road Patrol Officer with the Hollywood Police Department (HPD) in Hollywood, Florida. After two years on the road he moved into a Street Crimes position for a year, then becoming a detective working in undercover narcotics for the next 13 years. Eddie then transitioned to a position specializing in General Assignment, Robbery, and Economic Crimes to end his 30 year career with HPD. He retired for one day before starting his new journey with DIFS.

In February 2012, Eddie joined the Division of Investigative & Forensic Services, Bureau of Workers' Compensation Fraud; where he was assigned to the West Palm Beach Field Office. He immediately became a mentor and role model to all detectives and supervisors he worked with. Eddie received the 2019 Workers' Compensation Bureau Detective of the Quarter (July-September) and went on to receive the State of Florida Workers' Comp Fraud Task Force (WCFTF) Premium Fraud Investigators/Law Enforcement Officers of the Year 2019 Award in recognition of outstanding results in the fight against premium fraud.
