Course Description:

This course is designed to prepare the student to understand the Florida Statues, Administrative Codes, and NFPA 10 as related to the installation, service, inspections, and maintenance of fire extinguishers and the responsibilities of the Licensee and the Technician. Students will learn the responsibilities for oversight of fire equipment dealers and technicians as enforced by Fire Safety Inspectors and Fire Marshals (statute: 633.304)

Attendance: Students are required to attend all sessions of the course.

- Excused absences Students are permitted excused absences totaling no more than 10% of class (4.5 hours maximum), the instructor shall be the sole determining authority in the determination of an excused absence and may assign supplemental work to make up for missed class time.
