Wildland Firefighter Training Information:

Florida firefighters are required to obtain the national basic wildland firefighter training, which is the NWCG S-130/S-190/L-180 curriculum. An instructor/course administrator **must be in place prior to beginning course work** and can be either:

 A qualified NWCG Instructor. This is an instructor who meets NWCG requirements and has an instructor agreement with the Florida Forest Service. These instructors will provide NWCG certificates (S-130/S-190) which are valid for both state and national wildland firefighter qualifications within FCDICE and the Incident Qualification System (IQS).

or

 A Florida Fire Service Instructor who has met the wildland training and experience requirements as designated by the Florida Fire Chief's Association. These instructors will provide FLA certificates (FLA-130/FLA-190) which are only valid for state wildland firefighter qualifications within FCDICE for deployment within the state of Florida.

In either case, course options are as follows:

- 1. Traditional classroom
- 2. Online/Blended (Wildland Learning Portal NWCG)
 - a. S-130 (Blended: Online + Field)
