Re: Section 440.40, Florida Statutes; Section 38F-6.007, Florida Administrative Code

This is to notify all interested parties that effective immediately, carriers may fulfill their obligation to provide compensation notices (a/k/a "broken arm poster") to their customers by obtaining such notices from any printer or other supplier of the carrier's choice. Compensation notices must still comply with the form and content requirements specified in section 440.40, Florida Statutes and section 38F-6.007, Florida Administrative Code.

Compensation notices are no longer for sale directly by the Division of Workers' Compensation.
