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Agency Role Mapping Handbook Overview

The Agency Role Mapping Handbook describes and documents the Florida PALM Solution (Florida PALM) roles related to the Florida PALM business process groupings being implemented during the Florida PALM Cash Management System (CMS) Wave. The Role Mapping Handbook is designed to assist agencies in completing the role mapping task for each Wave and ongoing maintenance of role assignments.

Using the Agency Role Mapping Handbook

The Role Mapping Handbook should be used by agencies to assist in completing your role mapping activities for the CMS Wave. The Florida PALM Project Team suggests agencies follow the steps below to complete your role mapping activities:

1. Review and become familiar with the roles in the Role Mapping Handbook and identify which roles your agency needs to map end users to.
 - a. All agencies should review and be familiar with the *All Agency End User Roles* section
 - b. Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) should also review and be familiar with the *DEO End User Roles* section
 - c. Department of Revenue (DOR) should also review and be familiar with the *DOR End User Roles* section
 - d. Department of Financial Services (DFS) should also review and be familiar with the *DFS End User Roles* section
2. For each CMS Wave end user within your agency, consider the actions they perform today and the actions they will perform within Florida PALM after the CMS Wave go-live.
3. Determine the Florida PALM role(s) that appropriately align with the actions each end user will perform within Florida PALM.
4. Once the Florida PALM role(s) have been identified, complete the End User Role Mapping Spreadsheet (provided as part of the Role Mapping Workshops) for each end user.

There are a few considerations when identifying what roles each CMS Wave end user should be assigned:

- Access to multiple business units - A select number of end users can be assigned multiple business units. The business units will apply to any roles the end user is assigned.
- Role compatibility - Certain end user roles are compatible or incompatible with other roles. This information is documented in the Separation of Duties columns in the End User Role tables and expanded upon in the Separation of Duties section.

Separation of Duties

Separation of duties identifies which roles must not be assigned to the same end user. These rules are put in place to avoid mapping an end user to roles that cause regulatory, internal, or financial control issues with a single position. For example, the end user who is assigned the Cash Transfer Processor role must not also be assigned the Cash Transfer Approver role because it would cause a control issue if the same end user approved the cash transfers they requested. CMS Wave end user roles that must not be assigned to the same CMS Wave end user are documented in the Separation of Duties columns in the End User Role tables.

There are also system rules that prevent certain actions from being performed in the system. For example, as documented in the Responsibilities column of the *All Agency End User Roles* table

below, a general ledger (GL) Approver can both create and approve GL journals. However, in Florida PALM, GL approvers will not be able to approve GL journals that they create.

Florida PALM Roles

In the CMS Wave, there are five main types of Florida PALM end user roles:

1. Maintainer
2. Processor
3. Approver
4. Reporter
5. Requester.

Each type of role has primary responsibilities within each Florida PALM module:

- A Processor role adds, reviews, and updates transactions. A processor role will typically send transactions to be approved to the approver role;
- An Approver role approves transactions added or updated by a processor role;
- A Maintainer role is an administrative role that manages exceptions, ChartField values, or other configuration data;
- A Reporter role runs and reviews reports; and
- A Requester role submits support requests (usually through Florida PALM forms) to other end users.

Each Florida PALM end user role in the CMS Wave is associated with one or more of the following five business process groupings:

- Account Management and Financial Reporting (AMFR),
- Accounts Receivables (AR),
- Cash Management (CM),
- Disbursement Management (DM), and/or
- Treasury Management (TM).

All Agency End User Roles

Agency end user roles that will support Florida PALM for the CMS Wave are documented in Table 1.

Agency-Specific End User Roles

Due to the enterprise wide activities that specific agencies perform, certain end user roles are only applicable to the agencies that perform this work. Agency-specific end user roles will be limited to users within that agencies business unit. These agency-specific end user roles that will support Florida PALM for the CMS Wave are documented in Tables 2 and 3. End user roles specific to Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) are documented in Table 2. End user roles specific to the Department of Revenue (DOR) are documented in Table 3.

DEO End Users Roles

DEO end user roles that will support Florida PALM for the CMS Wave are documented in Table 2. The roles in Table 2 should only be role mapped by DEO.

Workflow

Workflow is the defined process of routing transactions between two or more end user roles in Florida PALM to obtain approval. Multiple end users can be assigned to the same end user role, which may mean they have shared responsibilities in a workflow process. For the CMS Wave, there are three transaction workflows; Cash Transfer Approval, DFS Deposit Approval, GL Journal Approval. During the CMS Wave, agency workflow will be contained within a Business Unit.

Cash Transfer Approval

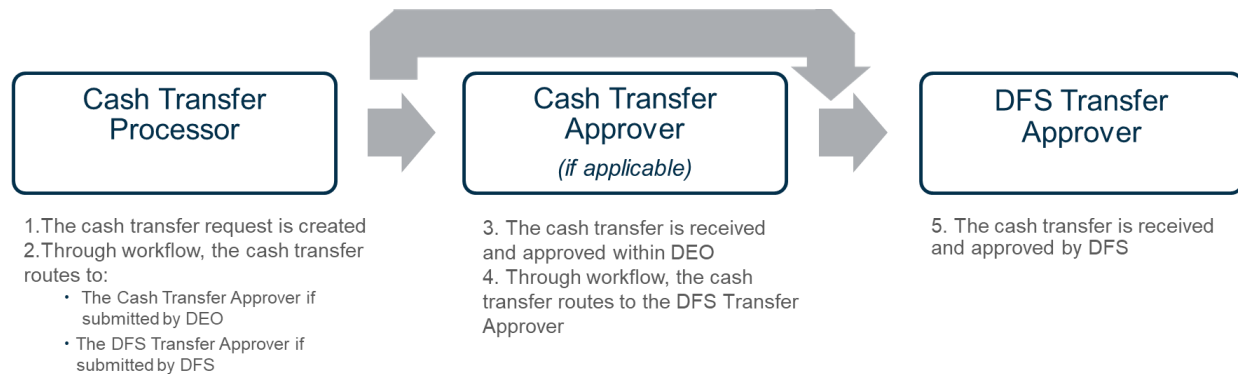


Figure 1: Cash Transfer Approval Workflow Steps

Workflow occurs between the Cash Transfer Processor role (assigned to an end user within the DEO Business Unit or an end user within the DFS Business Unit), the Cash Transfer Approver role (assigned to an end user within the DEO Business Unit), and the DFS Transfer Approver role (assigned to an end user within the DFS Business Unit). The process steps for this workflow are documented in Figure 1.

DFS Deposit Approval

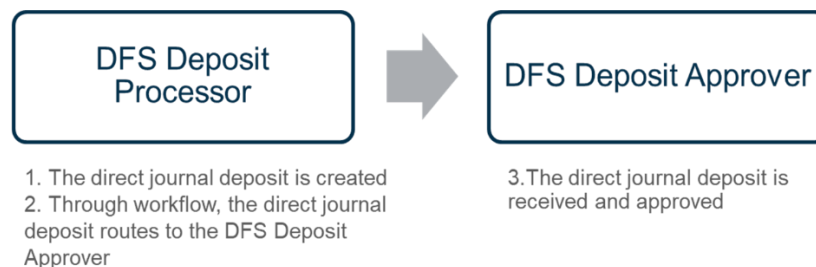


Figure 2: DFS Deposit Approval Workflow Steps

Workflow occurs between the DFS Deposit Processor role and the DFS Deposit Approver role. The process steps for this workflow are documented in Figure 2.

GL Journal Approval

Workflow occurs between the GL Journal Processor role (assigned to an end user within an agency Business Unit), the GL Journal Approver role (assigned to an end user within an agency Business Unit), and the DFS GL Journal Approver role (assigned to an end user within the DFS Business Unit). The process steps for this workflow are documented in Figure 3.
